Minutes of Area Meeting Held at Victoria Inn, Threemilestone, Truro, 15/2/18.

The meeting commenced at 7.10pm with apologies for absence received from St. Austell club. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as correct. Commenting on items arising from that meeting, delegate Pete queried progress on setting up our Facebook link and also whether any material had arisen for the BMFA News page. Chairman Mark confirmed that he had been in discussion with Andy Symons regarding this and that there would be a link from our website to Facebook, also, our treasurer Barrie would be assisting with this. Regarding the item for the BMFA News, the secretary confirmed that he would be arranging this. During officers reports the chairman commented on the continued poor weather; his club R.C. Cornwall had been continuing to use the nearby college hall for indoor flying, but the hours were limited and extra flyers from other clubs would be welcomed. Mark also informed us that he had attended a police-run "drone awareness" day that had been held at Crownhill, Plymouth, which had proved informative. The secretary commented on the closure of our former venue and would pursue enquiries when they re-opened; there had been a change of officers at Bude and our records were updated. Treasurer Barrie Gallie had been having difficulty arranging the change of names on the Area account, additional form-filling now complete he hoped to have the process completed shortly. Delegate Pete had attended the first Council meeting in January and would be going to the Area council meeting due in two days time. The secretary rose the subject of future legacy/contingency communication with Leicester and it was confirmed that paper notification would still continue. Discussing future events, members were reminded of the planned Swapmeet at Ladock on 28/4; R.C. Cornwall were holding an auction sale on 31/3 at Barripper, and Truro would be hosting a Fly for Fun on 24/6. It was also confirmed that the Ladock hall had been booked for a further swapmeet in November.. Meeting closed 8.15pm.
