Minutes of Area Meeting
Held 3/5/13, Clock & Key Inn, Trispen, Truro.

The meeting was opened at 7.00pm. by the chairman, who welcomed members present. Apologies for absence were received from Pete Austin and Kingsley Martin. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as correct. Arising from that meeting it was felt that our Aerobic competition should be re-arranged in order to avoid clashing with Woodspring's event, and the host club, Truro, agreed to hold this the following week, Sunday 14th July. During officers reports our chairman felt we had all been affected by poor weather this year and urged all clubs to support our various events this year. A new club, the R.C. Cornwall Flyers had recently formed and their representative was welcomed. The secretary echoed the chairman's comments and informed members that adverts for our events had been distributed throughout the county and letters sent to all clubs with details. The treasurer confirmed that our accounts had been prepared and we held £1538 at the end of March. Our grant for this year was still awaited from Leicester. Delegate Pete Disney had no recent meetings to report on, however he was able to advise us on discussions with the National Trust relating to recent activities at St. Agnes. Andrew Hothersall informed members of his recent visit to Merryfield for the jet exam and training day which had received widespread support from the south-west region; he was thanked for his comments and members agreed payment of his £40 expenses. Our inter-club competitions were all set to proceed as previously discussed, Scale at St. Austell 11/5/13, Fly-for- Fun at Redruth 26/5/13 , and Aerobatics at Truro now on 14/7/13. It was confirmed that Redruth clubs summer show would be on 2/3/4 August. Ron Marking told members of a series of summer competitions that Cornwall Vintage Aeromodellers were running through the year for the Tomboy design and 2 channel radio at various sites in the county. It was proposed by Redruth and seconded by Davidstow that the area should make a donation to St. Austell club to assist with the costs incurred following last years arson event; this was discussed and agreed by all and an amount of £100 would be given to them. There being no further business the meeting was closed at 8.15 pm..
