Minutes of Annual General Meeting Held 28/11/14, Clock & Key Inn, Trispen, Truro.

The meeting was opened at 7.05pm. by chairman Pete Lander who welcomed the healthy support present, apologies for absence having been received from Peter Austin, Truro. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as correct, and there were no matters arising from them. The chairman commented that his first year had passed so speedily, however the generally good weather had enabled most clubs to enjoy flying this year. Our planned events had been affected by wind and other attractions and he felt clubs might wish to talk about the format of events for next year. The secretary confirmed that all our meetings through the year had been well attended and debates had been in good spirit. Of the major issues the continued Area system had been well-aired and our views conveyed by our delegate. As with the chairman he suggested clubs talk to their members about their wishes for activities next year. Treasurer Mike Till then covered the seasons income and expenditure account, copies of which all clubs had available and members thanked him for this. Delegate Pete Disney confirmed that he had attended all the meetings at Leicester through the year, then reported on the last Area council meeting , presenting copies of the papers issued in reponse to the debate on the Area structure. After discussing the B.M.F.A. a.g.m. held the previous week Pete then presented Ron Marking with the Gamage Cup which he had won in the Open Rubber class; Ron recieved a round of applause from members for his success. The future of the Area structure had generated debate and Pete confirmed that the concensus view was for things to remain unchanged, there would however be a further discussion at Leicester next year. The accounts were proposed for adoption by Culdrose, seconded C.V.A., approved correct and signed. The election of officers then lead to both Treasurer Mike Till and Delegate Pete Disney being re-elected unopposed, both receiving warm appreciation for their efforts. Members then appointed Mark Milne Area Chief Examiner and acheivement scheme controller, and the auditors would be Kingsley Martin and Ron Marking. There being no further business the meeting closed at 7.45pm..
