Minutes of Annual General Meeting Held at Falmouth Arms, Ladock, Friday 4/12/15

The meeting was opened at 7.15 by the chairman who welcomed everyone present; apologies for absence had been received from Mike Till and Pete Austin. The minutes of the last meeting were then read and approved as a correct record and signed, there being no matters arising from them. The officers reports then followed, with chairman Pete Lander observing that he had now completed two years and enjoyed contributing to the area process; all our events had been severely affected by the years continued poor weather and he thanked all clubs for their attempts to hold such days during the year.

Secretary Paul Greet acknowledged the comments regarding this years weather which had affected most of the country. Members were reminded of the reasons for continuing to hold and support such events and encouraged to return to their clubs and promote future activities; the purpose and function of the area meetings and the impact our votes could have should also be impressed on club members who were unclear of the area role within the B.M.F.A. ; additional comments were made on the control of drones.

The treasurer's report was read by the chairman and members raised no questions to this. Our delegate Pete Disney confirmed that he had attended all meetings at Leicester during the year, and covered around 2300 miles on our behalf; members applauded his efforts. Pete said that we were very well supported in comparison to other area's, and confirmed that further guidance on drone use was now being put into practice and widely available. Further enquiries were being made regarding a possible national flying site, and he also confirmed recent changes to our insurance that had been agreed. Members were then asked to consider the accounts that had been supplied and these were proposed for adoption by Pete Disney, seconded Pete Lander, agreed by all, and adopted. Election of officers resulted in chairman Pete Lander and secretary Paul Greet being re-elected unopposed. The role of Chief Examiner was taken by Mark Milne, - proposed Truro, seconded St.Austell, agreed by all. Auditors appointed were Ron Marking and Kingsley Martin. There being no further business the meeting closed at 8.45pm..
