Minutes of Annual General Meeting Held 30/11/12, Hawkins Arms, Zelah, Truro.

The meeting opened at 7.15pm with the chairman thanking those present for attending the occasion. The role of Area Chief Examiner and Achievement scheme co-ordinator was appointed to Andrew Hothersall, Redruth, by a unanimous vote.
